Under normal operating conditions the RNLI system will record and store vessel positional data and messaging data received from an MOB Guardian unit for 72 hours before permanent deletion. In the event of an activation that results in a SAR mission, the positional and messaging data received from the casualty's MOB Guardian and stored in the RNLI system relating to the period leading up to the activation of the MOB Guardian unit and all subsequent positional and messaging data from the MOB Guardian unit, will be exported and securely held at RNLI HQ pending any request from the MAIB or court order.

David McMurdo – fishing vessel *Guyona*



When the fishing vessel *Guyona* suddenly got into trouble near the Channel Islands, the crew didn't have time to deploy the liferaft or send a Mayday before the boat capsized and sank. They could only abandon ship and hope.

Fortunately the *Guyona* was fitted with MOB Guardian, so when its position reports ceased, the system automatically alerted the RNLI. The alert was then actioned by the Coastguard and within 25 minutes of the St Peter Port lifeboat being alerted, all three men were safely onboard.

MOB Guardian keeps your location confidential

MOB Guardian sends regular confidential position reports via satellite from your vessel to the RNLI's operations room. When a scheduled report is missed, an alert is raised, and once verified that the boat is at sea and could be in trouble, the details are passed to the Coastguard.

Let MOB Guardian look out for you

MOB Guardian will help to protect you, your crew and your livelihood. It will also give your loved ones back at home the reassurance that you're as safe as possible while you're at sea.

EFF funding to support MOB Guardian is available for fishermen in England, Scotland and Wales. Separate grant arrangements may be available in Jersey, Guernsey and the Isle of Man. If you are in doubt or have any queries call the MOB Guardian help line on 01202 663142.

Insurance company support

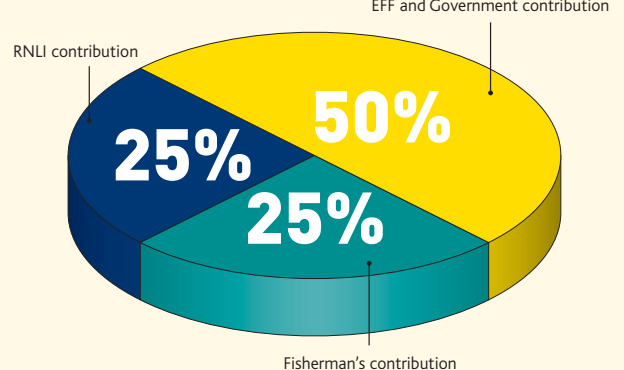
Customers with insurance policies with either Sunderland Marine Mutual Insurance Company Limited or the Scottish Boatowners Mutual Insurance Association can claim 25% of the capital cost excluding VAT. Once MOB Guardian has been fully installed and commissioned, claims can be made direct to either insurance company with proof of installation and commissioning.

Revised pricing

Grants of up to 50% of the installed price from participating Governments, made up of EFF and Government funding, and additional aid from the RNLI of £372.50, mean that most fishermen can install MOB Guardian for **£372.50** plus the gross VAT including 5 years' airtime.

The 2009 MOB Guardian offer will enable UK fishermen (who receive EU and/or Government aid) to install and operate this essential safety system for as little as **15% of the true cost**. This is because MOB Guardian will now be supported by **5 years' free airtime** for both new and existing users.

What happens next?

Installation of a standard MOB Guardian package is included within the purchase price for vessels of 15m and under. Please read carefully the Terms and Conditions below and contact the AST Help Desk on 08718 118200 with any queries, or if you are over 15m LOA.

AST Standard MOB Guardian Installation Terms and Conditions

Applied Satellite Technology Ltd (AST) or their agents are the approved installation contractors for MOB Guardian. AST warrants to provide a professional installation service of MOB Guardian within the UK via its installation network. All installations will be subject to current health and safety regulations and comply with professional marine engineering working practices.

Appointment booking

The intent of AST is to be reasonable and work with all parties to provide a professional standard installation service as detailed below.

Following the purchase of MOB Guardian, AST will contact the purchaser to agree a suitable installation date (Monday – Friday) with an AST engineer or our approved agent. The agreed date will be confirmed via email, fax or letter to the purchaser.

The working day before an installation, AST will attempt to make contact by telephone to confirm attendance of the vessel and installation engineer. AST reserve the right to apply a 'no show' fee of up to £480 plus VAT if you fail to give written notice of cancellation at least 3 days prior to an agreed installation appointment.

In the event of unforeseen circumstances, AST will endeavour to avoid incurring costs by reassigning engineers if possible. If an AST engineer cannot attend an appointment due to unforeseen circumstances, AST will endeavour to inform the purchaser at the earliest opportunity by telephone.

Standard installation includes:

- installations carried out in mainland UK. Installations outside the mainland and in some remote locations may still qualify where AST has a local MOB Guardian approved installation agent located in the vicinity of the vessel. Please contact AST for a definitive list
- vessels up to a maximum of 15m LOA
- surface mounting of all connecting cables and MOB Guardian unit
- a demonstration of the functionality of MOB Guardian to familiarise the user

Installation will be guaranteed for 7 days following installation for any non warranty faults and configuration issues. Please report all faults to AST on their helpline number 08718 118200.

Faults reported outside the 7-day period will be treated as warranty repairs if within 12 months of the date of installation. If a fault is assessed as not covered by the warranty the owner will be liable for the repair work costs. All faults should be reported to AST using the helpline number 08718 118200.

A standard installation kit comprises:

- 1 x base unit with trunion bracket (20 x small cable ties to secure cables to internal earth plate)
- 2 x personal safety units with lanyards
- 1 x GPS antenna with bracket and 10m cable
- 1 x remote head unit (RHU) with bracket and 10m cable
- 1 x Iridium modem/antenna with bracket and 10m cable
- 1 x klaxon including 10m four-core cable

- 1 x 8m power cable
- 1 x MOB Guardian operator's handbook
- 1 x installation manual

Standard installation does not include:

- installations outside of mainland UK unless agreed beforehand by AST
- vessels over 15m in length
- any fabrication, welding, bespoke brackets, cable trunking (including the fitting of goose necks) and the supply of glands and/or carpentry
- any accessories not supplied in the standard installation kit

Owner/operator responsibilities:

- power supply to be compatible with MOB Guardian guidelines and within 8m of MOB Guardian unit
- the MOB Guardian base unit requires 12/24v DC and can only be housed in a wheel house or water protected compartment

Important notice – over 15m vessels

Vessels of over 15m LOA may require additional remote head units (RHU) for the MOB device to operate effectively and a survey by a qualified AST engineer or installation agent will be required before an order can be accepted. Please contact AST to arrange a survey prior to placing an order. For the sake of clarity, any additional RHUs are partially grant aided in line with the RNLI's agreement. However, any costs associated with the survey* will be at the owner's expense.

*A standard survey is estimated to cost not more than £100.00 + VAT to include 2 hours – approved labour and local travel costs.

Non-standard installations

Any additional work to the standard installation as detailed above such as fabricating, welding, cable trunking, bespoke fitting or brackets etc. is at the skipper/owner's request and expense. This must be agreed with AST prior to the commencement of the installation. Contact AST directly on 08718 118200 for an estimate.
